PATRONAGE CAN LOWER YOUR COST OF BORROWING

What is Patronage?

When you work with Farm Credit, you're not just a customer - you're a member of our Association.

One of the many benefits of cooperative membership is our unique patronage program, which reduces your cost of borrowing by sharing a portion of our Association's profits with you.



Patronage is the portion of our earnings that we return to our member-owners.



When you take out a loan with Farm Credit, you purchase stock in the Association, making you a member-owner.



Each year, our Board of Directors determines how much of the prior year's profits can be returned to our member-owners, while retaining enough capital to fund future growth.



Eligible members receive patronage via check or direct deposit. The amount of patronage paid to each member is based upon the volume of business they conducted with Farm Credit during the previous year.

Cash-Back Distributions in Rate Reduction

In 2024, our Board of Directors approved a patronage and capital plan to create more consistent patronage distributions and ensure stability for the Association's capital levels. The intent is to return the equivalent of an approximate 1% reduction in your interest rate each year, barring any unforeseen events.

Permits & Plans Required:

- Local township consult for specific requirements needed to proceed with construction project
- Sediment & Erosion Control Plan stamp on plans
- Storm Water Management Plan stamp on plans
- Building Permit (Zoning Permit)
- Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP)
- Odor Management Plan (OMP)
- Confined Animal Feeding Operation (CAO/CAFO) permit
- Farm Credit is able to provide Letters of Credit if required for construction

Beginning of Construction:

- SITE PLAN MUST BE FOLLOWED
- Builders risk policy to be provided
- Invoices needed to support disbursement
- Inspections will be conducted to verify work has been completed per invoice & site survey

End of Construction:

- Documentation of permanent insurance in place
- Township Write Off
- Retain log book per integrator requirements
